Assessment, day and evening intensive outpatient, substance abuse education, family education and support, psychiatric evaluation, consultation, monitoring, and medication review, dual diagnosis and early recovery groups, individual and group therapy based on the unique needs of the individual, community education, adolescent outpatient treatment for ages 12 –18 yrs.
